- ◆ The six “Big Ideas” that are fundamental to the new AP Chemistry course will be reviewed.
- ◆ After discussion, participants will be invited to perform and to discuss experiments in each of the areas.
- ◆ Participants will receive a CD of the lab manual containing the inquiry labs and detailed teacher notes for each lab that allows for modification of each experiment.
- ◆ All experiments have been correlated to a primary learning objective (s) and science practices as outlined in the College Board Curriculum .
- ◆ An appendix contains additional questions (with answers) teachers can ask students either during a pre-lab session or a post-lab analysis.
